- Variety labeled Protected Designation of Origin (Green lentils du Puy)

Earliness	Mid-early to early
Height	Medium

Crop management

Lentils have low pedo-climatic requirements.
Lentil is easy to grow and an excellent break crop.

Sowing

Sowing density:

350 gr/m², so around 100 kg/ha. In altitude and late sowing, increase sowing density by 10 to 20%

Sowing date:

15th of April - plain areas

15th of April to 15th of May - altitude areas

Give priority to good and surficial soils, avoid too clayed soils.

Anicia is mainly intended for human food. It is the only variety allowed in the Protected Designation of Origin Green lentils du Puy and the Red Label Green lentils du Berry
