AO's results, sowing in August



Sowing from April to early September

Spring and summer sowing

Manage the crop as spring oat

Cover Crop sowing (after harvest to early September)

Prioritize sowing after harvest to keep soil moisture Adapt sowing density to reach a sufficient soil cover Reduce seed density in case of mixing with other species as pulses for example



Destruction

The cover crop can be destroyed by freeze (depending on crop stage), rolling or ploughing.
